Dear Candidates:

In an effort to ensure compliance with applicable state law and local ordinance, the City is respectfully requesting all candidates' cooperation in the following respects regarding the placement of campaign or political signs.

Political signs within the City of Weatherford are considered seasonal signs and subject to the following regulations per WMC 12-4-101:

- Seasonal signs are exempt from permit (as long as they adhere to the below regulations)
- No more than two (2) signs may be displayed on any property at the same time.
- Each sign is limited to eight (8) square feet in size for residential uses and twenty-four (24) square feet in size for nonresidential uses.
- The typical display time for a seasonal sign is sixty (60) days or less.

Additionally, all candidates should ensure the following when placing signs:

- Avoid placement of signs on City property or in any public right-of-way; and
- Avoid placement of signs on any utility poles, light standards or other public facility; and
- Avoid placement of signs in areas which will obstruct drivers' clear view of intersections; and
- Obtain property owner permission before placing signs on private property.

If you are unsure whether an area is residential or nonresidential, please contact the City's planning department at 817-598-4284 prior to the placement of a sign or utilize the zoning district feature on the City's GIS maps: <https://gis.weatherfordtx.gov/map>
