





## SEPTEMBER CHALLENGES:

HISTORICALLY VEHICLE BURGLARIES  
INCREASE BY 100% IN OCTOBER

ACCIDENTS INCREASED BY 8%  
118% INCREASE ON I20

DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE INCREASED BY 77%  
ASSAULTS INCREASED BY 38%

CIVIL STANDBYs INCREASED BY 45%

## RESULTS:

ONLY 2 VEHICLE BURGLARIES  
REPORTED IN OCTOBER

ACCIDENTS INCREASED BY 17%  
95% INCREASE ON I20

DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE DECREASED BY 46%  
ASSAULTS INCREASED BY 38%

ONLY 3 CIVIL STANDBYs  
CONDUCTED IN OCTOBER

## OCTOBER CHALLENGES:

FORGERY CASES HAVE INCREASED BY 405%  
STEMMING FROM POST OFFICE THEFTS

CRIMINAL MISCHIEF REPORTS  
INCREASED BY 104%

ASSAULT OFFENSES INCREASED 38%


