JANUARY CHALLENGES:

BURGLARY OF BUILDING CASES INCREASED BY 214%, MOSTLY STEMMING FROM HOMETOWN SELF STORAGE BREAK-INS.

DWI RELATED CRASHES HAVE STEADILY INCREASED THE LAST 3 MONTHS, 42% STEM FROM OPEN CONTAINERS

HISTORICALLY HOMELESS & WELFARE CALLS INCREASE IN JANUARY

RESULTS:

NO BURGLARY OF BUILDING CASES IN JANUARY

ONLY 2 DWI RELATED CRASHES REPORTED IN JANUARY, 17 DWI ARRESTS (REMIND NEW OFFICERS TO ASK ABOUT ALCOHOL SOURCE)

66% DECREASE IN HOMELESS REPORTS AND 13% DECREASE IN WELFARE CALLS FROM JANUARY 2023

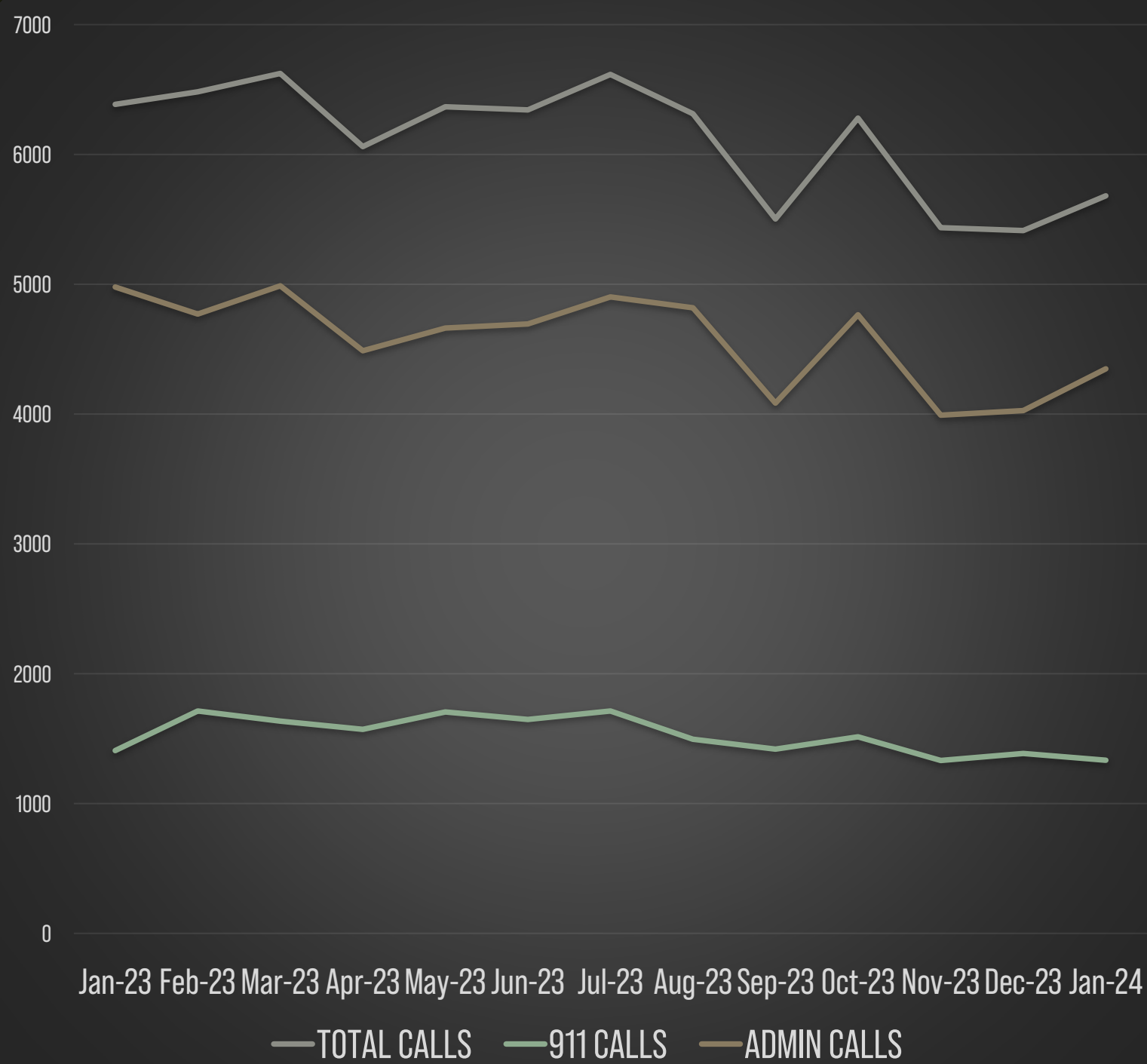
