





MAP BURGLARY & THEFT MAP







OCTOBER CHALLENGES:

DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE AND ASSAULT CASES HISTORICALLY INCREASE DURING SEPT-DEC

PROPERTY CRIME REPORTS INCREASE DURING HOLIDAYS

WELFARE & PANHANDLING CALLS INCREASE DURING HOLIDAYS

RESULTS:

DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE DECREASED BY 23%, ASSAULTS INCREASED BY 10%

BMVs INCREASED BY 48%, ALL OTHERS DECREASED

WELFARE CALLS INCREASED BY 44%, PANHANDLING INCREASED BY 7%
